Application Process - To be in with a chance of winning you simply need to adhere to the following:

- Your organisation must be a museum, gallery or heritage visitor attraction, which is currently open to the public, and which is based in the UK
- Your application must relate to a specific project and the project concerned must have a total budgetary spend of no more than £5,000.
- Your project could be, but does not need to be limited to: an educational or community initiative, the creation of a temporary or permanent exhibition, a restoration or conservation project or even audience development. Your application must, however, clearly illustrate how the Prize will be used and the positive difference it will make to the successful delivery of the project.
- The project must be fully implemented during the period 1 June 2017 – 30 April 2018 but can continue to run/be open beyond
- Using the template provided, you just need to tell us, in no more than 250 words, what the project is and how £1,000 would make a difference to the delivery of it
- 1 signed hard copy of your template application should be handed in at the Museums + Heritage Show information desk and is the only form of entry accepted. Digital versions sent before or after the Show will not be accepted and it is a condition of entry that you must attend the Show.

We will endeavour to notify the winning applicant by Friday 9 June 2017. No feedback will be provided to those applicants who are unsuccessful.

The winning applicant will be required to submit a short completion statement and images of their project which may be published on Museums + Heritage Advisor.
